The Department of Labor has recently announced a notable change to the Fair Labor Standards Act's minimum salary threshold for overtime pay.

## Pay Schedule Update

As the University continues to modernize and streamline business processes, we are announcing an important change to our payroll frequencies.

Beginning Dec. 1, 2024, employees of Auburn and AUM who are currently paid monthly will switch to a biweekly pay schedule, meaning they will be paid every two weeks. This change will mostly affect A&P (Administrative & Professional) employees, 12-month Faculty, and students in a graduate assistantship.
