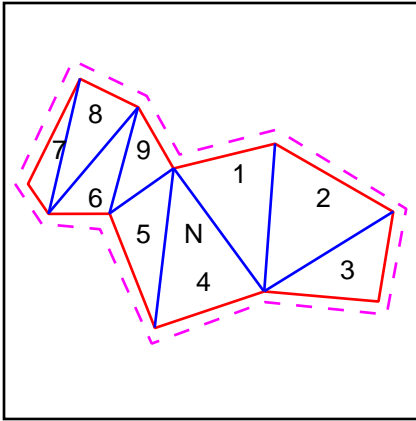


1.0 BASIC CONCEPTS

Sewing By Numbers

Step 1 - Tracing



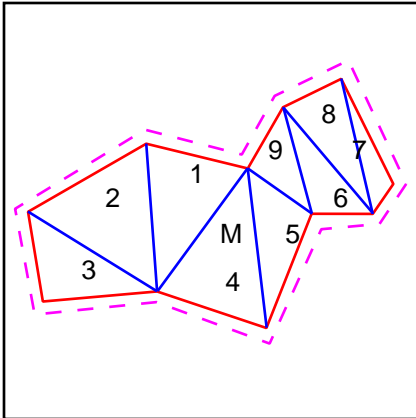
STITCH LINES ■
EXTRA LINES ■
SEAM LINES ■ (NOT ON PATTERNS)

Start by placing your cut peice untop of your surface. Hold it down and trace the outside of the shapes. Now measure out 1/4 inch from your edges and make a mark. These marks will become your seam lines. Cut on the seamline.

Notes:

- A. If the peices have numbers then also transfer them to the correct edges on the fabric for better indentification.
- B. If you trace a peice upright then mark the center with a **N** for normal. If you flip the peice then mark the center with an **M** for mirror.
- C. The 1/4 seam edge was what I use on my sewing machine.

Step 2 - WTF? I only have one side!



Flip the peices over and trace again. Remember to transfer the numbers to the correct locations. And then trace 1/4 inch around the edges for the seam.
