Professional Licensure: Does not meet	Disclosure Statement
CA	The Auburn University Counseling Psychology PhD program does not meet all the educational requirements to pursue a license as a Psychologist in the state of California. Additional California coursework is required, some of which can be taken as elective courses during doctoral training. Other coursework can be taken at any time throughout the license application process. Additional requirements, such as examinations, background checks, additional experience, fees, etc. may also apply. Students who are interested in working in California should review the state board website to determine additional requirements. The state board will evaluate each license application in its entirety to make a final decision regarding the applicant's eligibility.
WV	The Auburn University Counseling Psychology PhD program does not meet all the educational requirements to pursue a license as a Psychologist in the state of West Virginia. The West Virginia administrative code indicates that a clinically related psychology doctorate must be earned from a department that contains the word "psychology" or "psychological." Auburn's counseling psychology PhD program is earned through the Department of Special Education, Rehabilitation, and Counseling. Therefore, a degree from our program does not automatically qualify for license eligibility in West Virginia. The Board will review coursework and supervised professional experience upon application. Additional requirements, such as examinations, background checks, additional experience, fees, etc. may also apply. Students should review the state board website to determine additional requirements.
