****NOTICE****

PPR FOR AIRCRAFT WITH GREATER THAN 60-FOOT WINGSPAN

Beginning with the **2026 Auburn Tigers Football Season**, football gameday operations at Auburn University Regional Airport (AUO) will require Prior Permission Required (PPR) reservations for any aircraft with a wingspan **greater than 60 feet**. Due to ramp space limitations and critical wingtip clearance requirements, these aircraft must obtain an assigned PPR slot in advance to ensure safe and efficient parking accommodations.

Flight crews operating aircraft exceeding this wingspan threshold must contact AUO Customer Service at 334-844-4597 (Option 1) within 48 hours of the scheduled game day to request a PPR reservation.

Failure to notify the FBO in advance of arrival with a qualifying aircraft may result in additional handling fees and potential delays in service.

Parking Procedures

Arrivals

Customers are encouraged to arrive early, as parking spots are not guaranteed.

Non-Power 4 Conference Games

- **Main Terminal (FBO) Ramp** - Jet and turboprop parking.
- **North Ramp** - Piston aircraft parking.

SEC & Power 4 Conference Games

- **Runway 11/29 CLOSED** - **ALL** piston aircraft will be parked on the runway.
- **Main Terminal (FBO) and North Ramp** - All small and mid-sized jets and turboprops will be parked in the Main Terminal and North Ramp.
- **Large Corporate Jets** - A very limited number of Gulfstreams, Falcons, Challengers, Latitudes/Longitudes, and Sovereigns may be parked on the Main Terminal Ramp. Most will be parked on the West Ramp. This is due to wingtip clearance requirements and space constraints.
- **Overflow Parking** - Larger corporate jets and small/mid-sized turbine aircraft will be parked on the **West Ramp** as needed.

Parking Capacity Limits

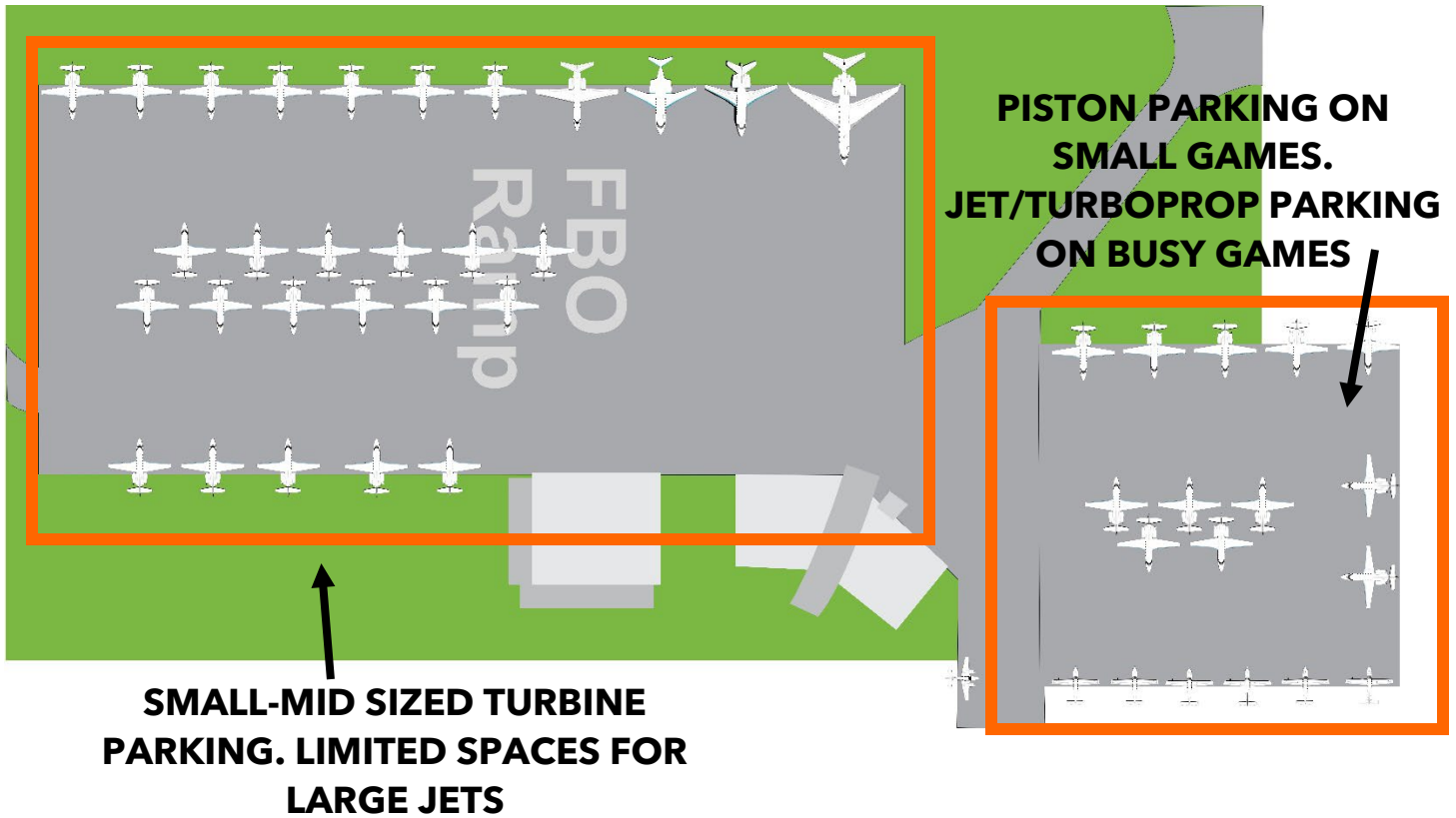
- In the rare event that parking capacity is reached, AUO will switch to **drop-off only operations**.
- The **control tower** will direct aircraft to appropriate parking or drop-off locations.

 **Please Note:** Parking locations are determined for safety and efficiency. Specific parking locations are not available on request.

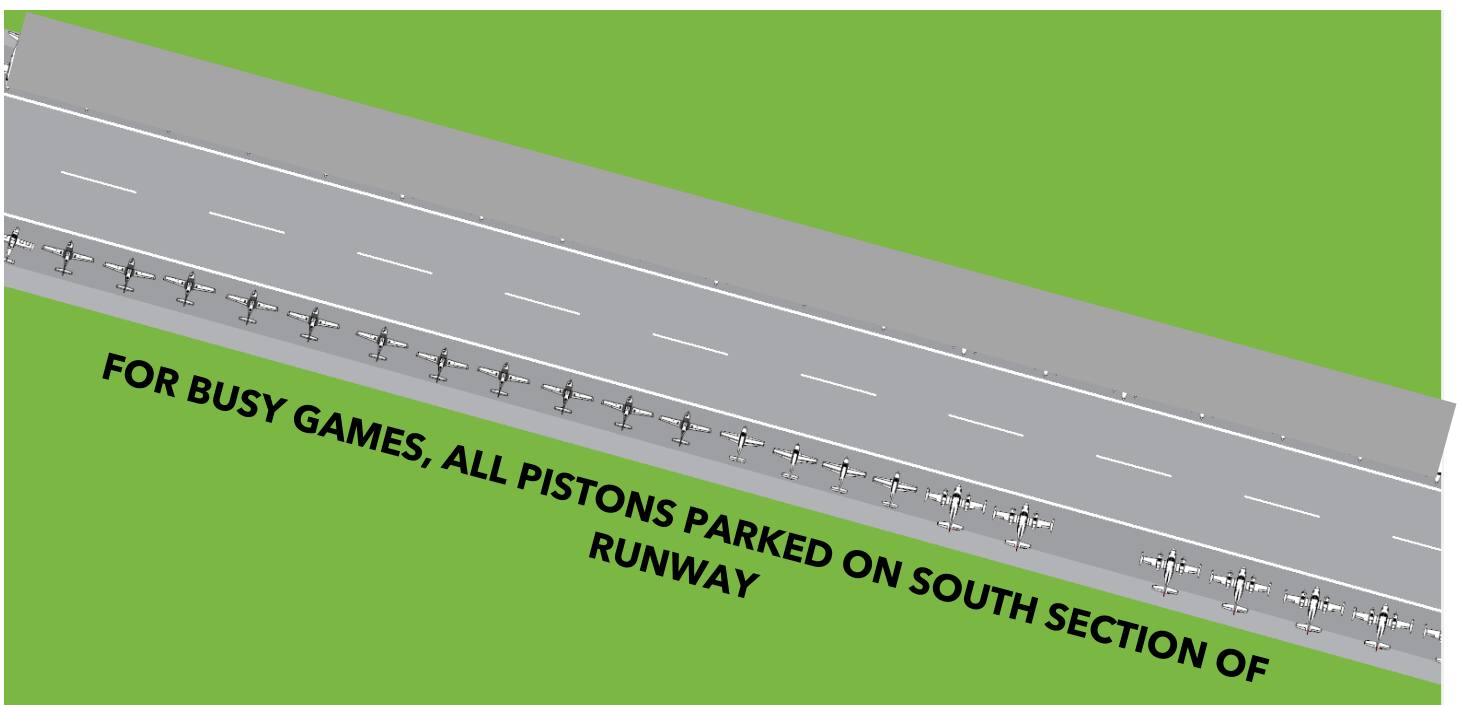


AUBURN UNIVERSITY
