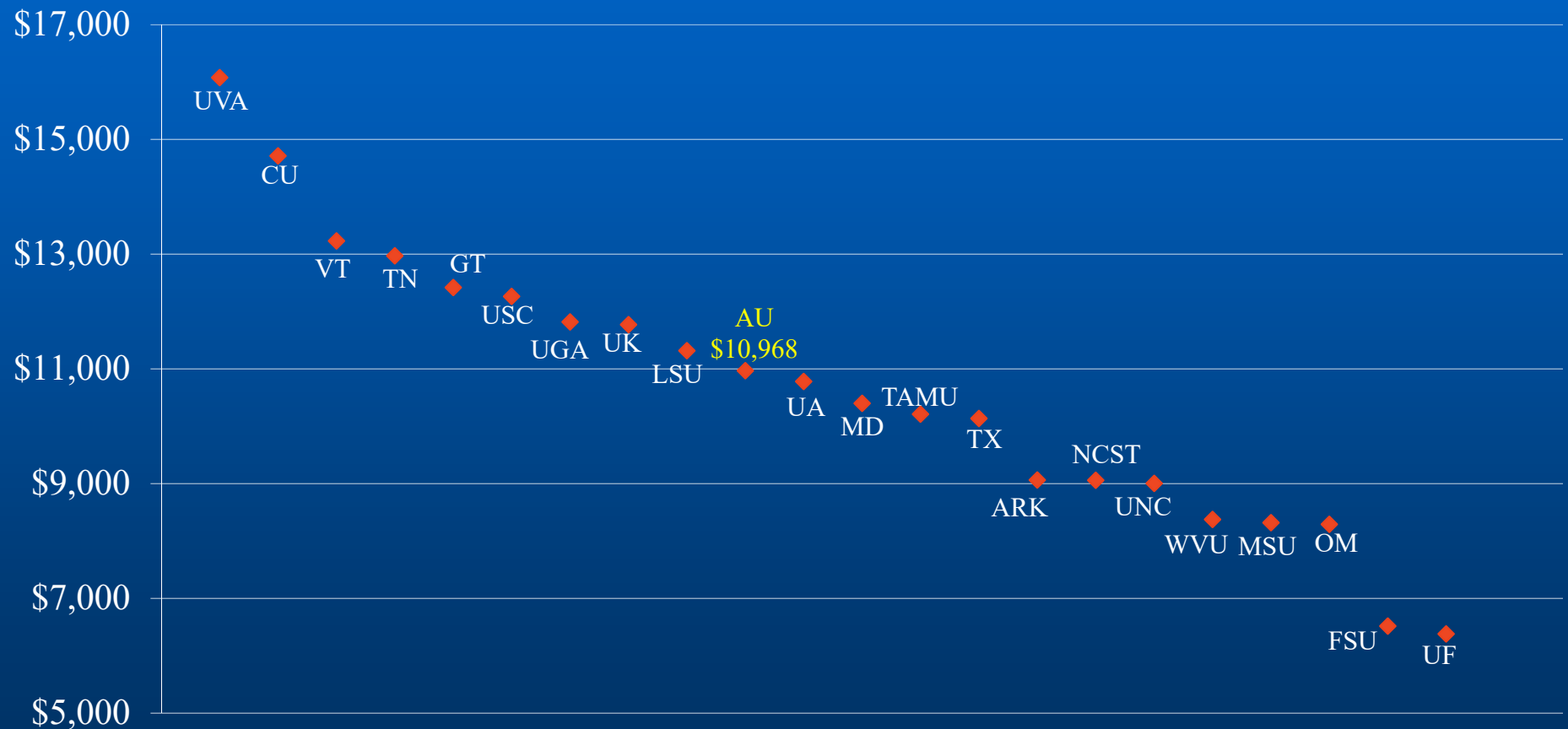

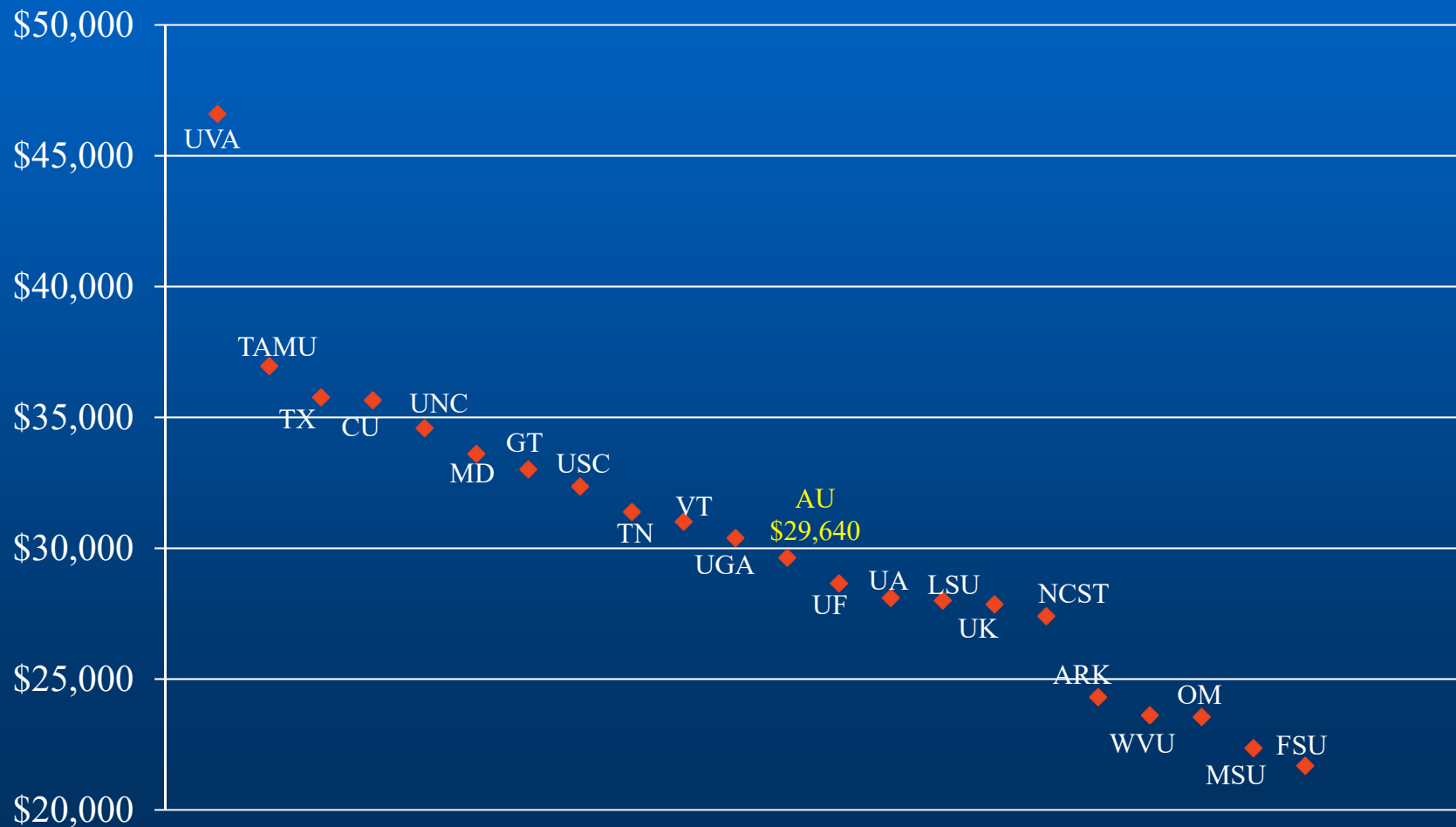

* Published tuition rates for fall of 2017 (includes fees) – Average - \$30,297

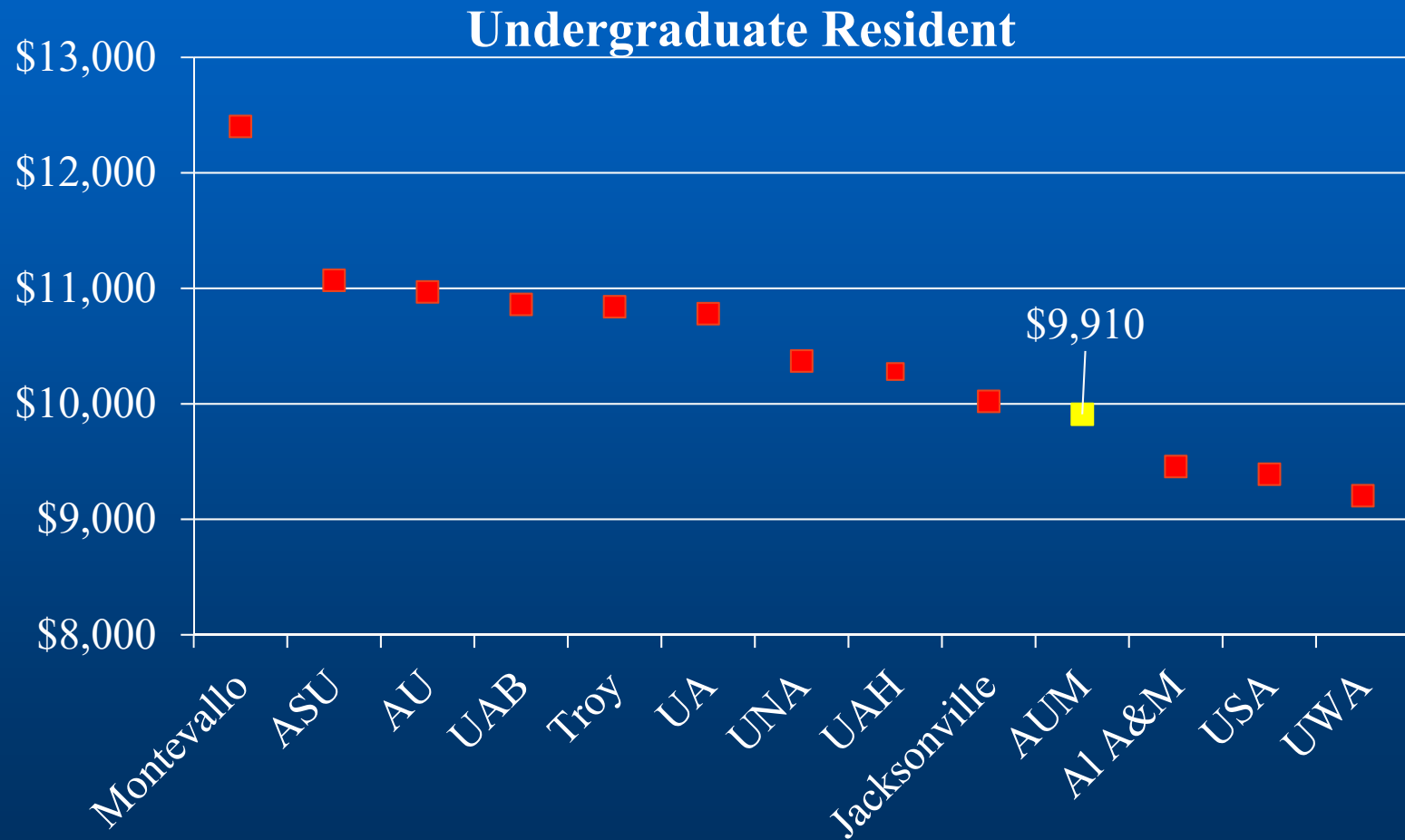

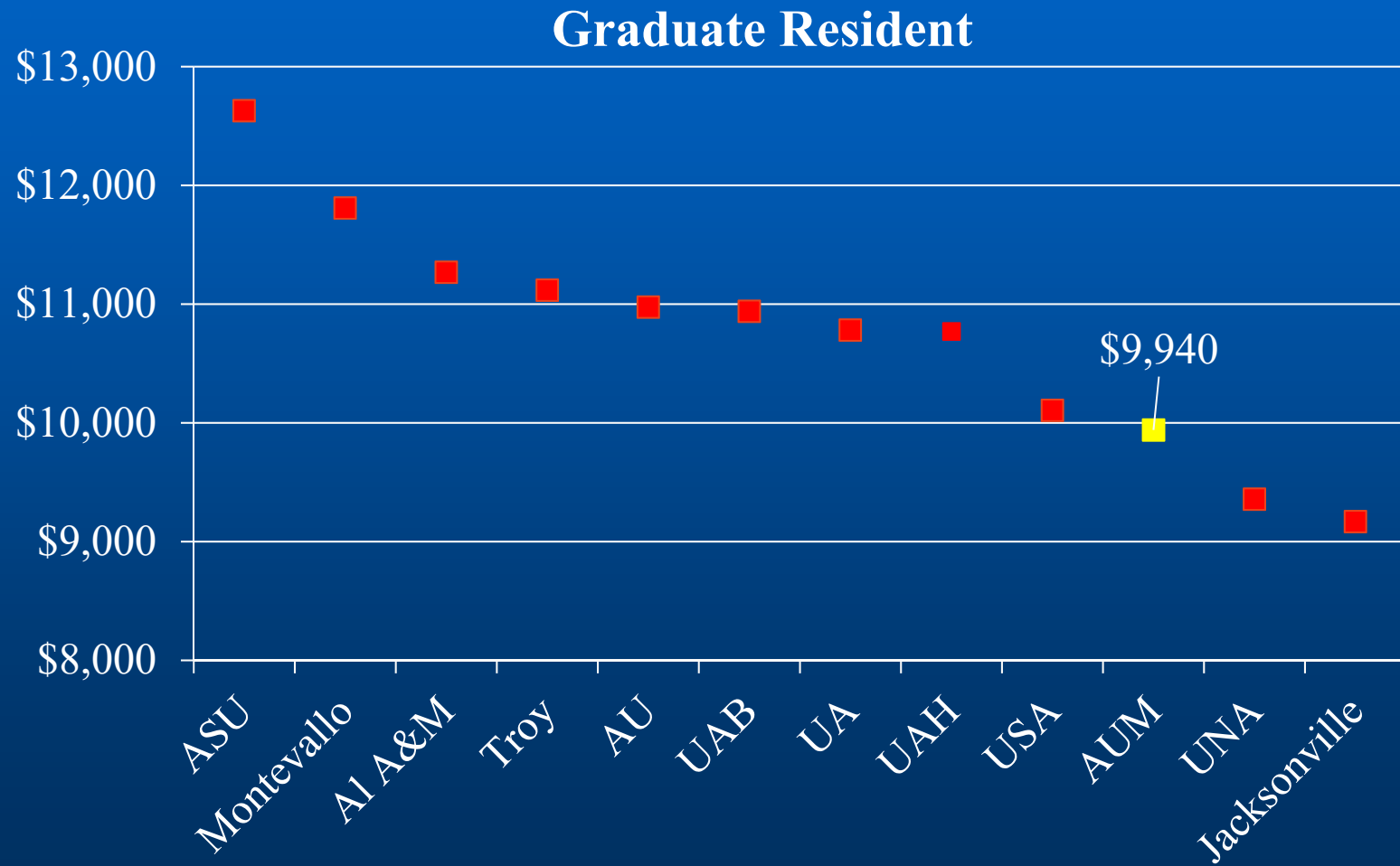
