STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES (SCPS)

- Personal/Mental Health Counseling
- Services include individual and group counseling, workshops, Zen Den rooms, and psychiatry
- Individual counseling is...
 - Brief: addressing specific goals with a defined end-point
 - Time-limited: providing the most help in the fewest number of sessions
 - 57.8% 1-5 sessions
 - 31.5% 6-10 sessions
 - Bi-weekly: SCPS typically meets with students for individual counseling every 2-3 weeks
- NO CHARGE for services and CONFIDENTIAL

GETTING CONNECTED

- Referrals
 - Call 334-844-5123
 - Business Hours are M-F 8:00 am until 5:00 pm
 - Come to a SCPS location:
 1) AU Medical Clinic Building, second floor
 2) Haley Center, ground floor
 - Also, College of Veterinary Medicine students can meet with an embedded counselor there
- Crisis/Emergency Services
 - Immediate access to an on-call clinician is available
 - Come into any SCPS location during business hours
 - Call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
 - If an immediate life-threatening situation, dial 911
 - National Suicide Crisis Lifeline: call 988 or text 741-741



SCPS WAITLIST

- Individual counseling is the ONLY service with a wait list
 - At intake, all other options are discussed with students (e.g., group, on-line workshops, community referral)
 - Consultations with case manager, e-mail check-ins, & assessing for changes
 - Wait time varies depending on urgency of need
 - In 2022-2023, 49.7% of students were assigned to a counselor within 7 days
- Significant improvements
 - Increased staff
 - Average wait time decreased by 55%
 - Continual reassessment of needs and resources

SCPS STAFF INFORMATION

PROFESSIONAL STAFF

- 22 full-time professional staff members
- Includes psychologists, social workers, and counselors
- Licensed in profession or working toward licensure under supervision

TRAINEES

- 4 full-time pre-doctoral psychology interns
- Practicum students from counseling psychology, clinical psychology, and social work
