The Chair and Secretary's Terms

- Chair (Three years of duties)
 - Chair-Elect
 - Chair
 - Immediate Past Chair
- Secretary (Two years of duties)
 - Secretary-Elect
 - Secretary

Chair and Secretary Support

- Salary Supplement (Chair; Secretary)
 - 33% for nine-month faculty
 - 25% for 12-month faculty
- Release Time
 - Funds to departments to support reduced teaching during year in office
- Travel Budget
 - Funds for one national conference related to academic leadership for chair; chairelect; secretary; and secretary-elect
 - Funds for attendance to twice-yearly Alabama Council of University Faculty Presidents for one officer
- Administrative Leave
 - Chair- Two semesters at full salary after full three-year term
 - Secretary- One semester at full salary after two year term

Nominating Processes

- Nominations for chair-elect and secretary-elect may also be made by petitions signed by at least ten faculty members. No faculty member shall sign more than one petition for the same office.
- Petitions presenting nominations shall be filed with the secretary not later than 14 calendar days prior to the spring meeting.
