JOB SUMMARY

Directs and oversees the production and distribution of multimedia materials for outreach and/or education programs.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Directs and oversees the video production of graduate courses to include training, scheduling and monitoring videographers, and ensures the quality of final products.
- Participates in strategic and operational planning of video production to include identifying, evaluating, recommending, design, and development of video and instructional technologies.
- Plans and initiates Outreach sections in the Banner system for each department offering distance learning courses each semester.
- Provides input into the development, implementation, and upgrades of distance learning video streams; works collaboratively to identify and resolve problems.
- Manages the day-to-day operations of video resources scheduling and staffing. Maintains more than 20 classrooms equipped for live recording to the national broadcast standards by staying up-to-date on media techniques, equipment, and processes.
