JOB SUMMARY

Performs various duties providing professional expertise for forestry and wildlife management tasks.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collects, records, summarizes, and reports forest inventory and ecological monitoring data with limited supervision.
- Conducts species (flora and fauna) surveys to ensure sustainable populations of threatened and non-threatened species. Independently analyses and reports on results obtained from surveys.
- Organizes and maintains established databases related to natural resources and wildlife management. Detects, diagnoses, and resolves database issues. Analyses and reports on results obtained from databases
- Produces presentation materials associated with the collected data, such as reports or MS PowerPoint presentations and may include information on species status, habitat conditions, and changes.
- Performs timber marking, herbicide treatments, prescribed burning, and other natural resources tasks.
- May provide support to recreational users, other natural resource managers, and tenet units.
- Plants food plots for wildlife, promoting their habitat and overall health.
- Conducts data collection for wildlife density and health studies, allowing for proper conservation and management strategies to be implemented.
- May work in duded impact areas with an explosive ordinance escort for endangered species requirements.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
