JOB SUMMARY

Directs and oversees sports programs, membership programs, day-to-day operations of the building and building maintenance segments of Campus Recreation.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversees and monitors the planning and review of budgets, programs, strategies, events, and schedules for assigned Campus Recreation programs.
- Oversees the day-to-day operations of the Recreation and Wellness Center.
- Directs, establishes, and reinforces the safety and usability of the Recreation and Wellness Center through oversight and scheduling of the facility.
- Identifies maintenance problems throughout the building and oversees minor maintenance work or schedules work with facilities staff to resolve problems.
- Responsible for ensuring that all of the audio/visual and electronic equipment is available when requested and is in a usable condition.
- Oversees the custodial staff ensuring that the cleanliness and sanitary conditions of the building are maintained.
