Performs other duties assigned for sports game day as needs are determined.</li> <li>Plans, organizes, and implements procedures to ensure the safety and compliance of athletic event programs for assigned gameday event planning.</li> <li>Responsible for assisting with football gameday event responsibilities for concourse and gate operations in addition to other aspects as assigned by event management leadership.</li> <li>Oversee the Assistant Director, student worker program &amp; graduate assistants to fully execute duties.</li> <li>Executes and ensures proper set-up and breakdown of athletic events following deadlines and safety regulations.</li> <li>Ensures assigned athletic events are conducted in accordance with university, local, federal, National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), and Southeastern Conference (SEC) rules and regulations.</li> <li>Complies with all applicable National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) and Southeastern Conference (SEC) regulations in the performance of job duties.</li> </ul>
