Job Summary

Oversees and coordinates administrative functions and operations for the Center for Arts and Humanities.

Essential Functions

- 1. Serves as the center's financial officer to include overseeing and managing center and project budgets.
- 2. Develops and implements major statewide and regional arts and humanities outreach projects.
- 3. Develops and supervises service learning and civic engagement initiatives.
- 4. Assists in the formulation of the center's long-range and strategic plans and lead the development and implementation of program evaluation.

Supervisory Responsibility

Full supervisory responsibility for other employees is a major responsibility and includes training, evaluating, and making or recommending pay, promotion or other employment decisions.

The above essential functions are representative of major duties of positions in this job classification. Specific duties and responsibilities may vary based upon departmental needs. Other duties may be assigned similar to the above consistent with the knowledge, skills and abilities required for the job. Not all of the duties may be assigned to a position.
