JOB SUMMARY

Develops and implements plans for transition services for students participating in a sexual offender specific treatment program.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develops and oversees implementation of psychoeducational curriculum modules to transition youthful offenders into and out of treatment programs.
- Provides assessment of individual youth's transitional needs.
- Coordinates with and acts as liaison to therpaists, court personnel, youths and their families, as well as other external agencies regarding release plans, placement issues, and community service delivery systems; coordinates with out-of-state agencies when necessary.
- Develops the vocational componenet of the Good Lives treatment model.
- Implements the alumni follow-up program, including the development of the Alabama Advisory Board.
- Coordinates with students' case managers to resolve transition and/or registration issues.
