Reporting to the Assistant Provost for International Program, this position directs the daily operations of the AU-National Cheng Kung University (AU-NCKU)Taiwan Center for Chinese Language and Culture, creating and establishing classes and programs for students and community members.

- Oversees and directs the daily operations of the AU-NCKU Taiwan Center for Language and Culture, creating language and cultural programs and coordinating with other academic initiatives such as language instruction in the Department of World Languages, Auburn First dual-credit programming in Alabama, and other sponsored programs.
- Develops and implements educational coursework (credit and non-credit) and programs to increase the quality, scalability, and sustainability of student learning opportunities at Auburn University and Alabama high schools.
- Hosts the Taiwan Center initiatives and visiting scholars.
- Develops and monitors the budget for the Taiwan Center and develops the strategic plan for the Center.
- Directs staff members, student interns, and language and culture instructors working in the center.
- May perform other duties as assigned.
