### JOB SUMMARY

Reporting to the Transit Service Supervisor, the University Shuttle Van Driver provides a safe and reliable transportation service to faculty and staff. Ensures operations are performed in accordance with University.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Safely operates state owned University vehicles while transporting passengers in accordance with all local, state, and federal traffic laws.
- Provides customer service and information to passengers as necessary in a polite and friendly manner which may include resolving customer issues.
- Ensures the University vehicle is clean and in safe condition reporting any problems or vehicle performance or maintenance issues immediately.
- Report any accidents or injuries according to the written policy.
- Assists with the training of new employees for driving techniques.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
