- Oversees all non-Auburn University Theatre groups and personnel using Auburn University Theatre facilities, ensuring safety and compliance with policies and procedures.
- Ensures the immediate safety of students and employees in accordance with shop safety standards.
- Ensures the maintenance and availability of all tools and supplies.
- Evaluates practicum students and provides feedback to faculty.
