JOB SUMMARY

Provides rehabilitative care to raptors at the Southeastern Raptor Center (SRC).

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides and assists with veterinary technical support and medical care for raptors under the directions of the veterinary staff.
- Collaborates with the Education Unit of the SRC to schedule and assist with the annual examination, treatment, and ongoing medical care for the educational raptor collection.
- Assists in the direction, supervision, and recruitment of volunteers for the Rehabilitation Unit of the SRC.
- Instructs veterinary students and volunteers in the proper handling, restraining, and triaging of raptors.
- Participates in lectures, presentations, programs, and research efforts relating to the SRC.
- Communicates with state and federal wildlife agencies and SRC personnel on matters relating to various professional association requirements and policies.
- May periodically update sections of the SRC website.
