Job Function: Animal Research

JOB SUMMARY

Performs a variety of tasks related to the veterinary care of animals under the auspices of the animal resource program.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assists veterinarians and researchers with research related medical and surgical procedures to include examinations, surgery and sample collection.
- Collects samples for the purposes of animal research, medical care and animal health surveillance.
- Performs rounds of animal facilities for the purposes of health monitoring and post-approval monitoring of animal research activities.
- Observes and records vital data, abnormal signs, body weight, and food/water intake of animals.
- Triages animal health, behavior and welfare problems reported by animal care staff.
- Assists veterinarians with preventative and case based medical care of animals.
- Operates, maintains, repairs and cleans equipment and laboratory and animal procedural areas.
- Administers medicine, routine vaccinations and other treatments as prescribed by veterinarians.
- Inventories and maintains supplies.
- Participates in training of investigators in the areas of animal handling, sample collection and procedures.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervisory Responsibility

May be responsible for training, assisting or assigning tasks to others. May provide input to performance reviews of other employees.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

For education and experience, minimum requirements are listed on the top row below.
