JOB SUMMARY

Custodian/Floor Care Technician performs basic housekeeping and floor care functions for University buildings.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Cleans and performs minor repairs on University buildings to ensure that facilities are in suitable condition for scheduled activities. Cleaning duties may include tasks such as cleaning bathrooms, dusting, removing trash, etc.
- Strips, sands, waxes, seals, buffs, sweeps, shampoos, and mops various types of floor surfaces.
- Maintains equipment and supplies in order to complete tasks.
- May assist in setting up for events.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervisory Responsibility

May be responsible for training, assisting or assigning tasks to others. May provide input to performance reviews of other employees.
