#### JOB SUMMARY

Maintains and inspects roof structures campus wide and makes repairs to drainage systems.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Inspects roofs for water and/or structural damage campus wide for needed repairs.
- Estimates and requests materials and supplies needed to complete job.
- Pressure washes roofs, buildings and sidewalks on campus as needed ensuring proper drainage.
- Coordinates the use of equipment and machinery from other departments.
- Adheres to safety requirements of the job to insure safety of workers and students (barricades, flag men etc.).
- Prepares roofing site by ensuring materials are available and groundcover and equipment is covered.
