JOB SUMMARY

Manages, plans, organizes, and implements major gifts fund-raising activities for Auburn University.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Manages and coordinates the functions and operations of the Major Gifts office to include budget and work plans.
- Assures good stewardship for all constituency gifts on behalf of the University and its Foundations and balances donor interests with University programs and Auburn's constituencies.
- Identifies potential prospects for cultivations through research, initial contact ratings, peer reviews, development officers, and other relevant resources and conducts follow-up actions to include initial contacts.
- At the direction of the Vice President for Development, interfaces with Deans, independent Center Directors, the Alumni Board and other senior representatives of Auburn University.
- Develops and implements procedures for the acceptance of gifts and prepares the University and its Foundations to receive these gifts through proper administrative and organization processes.
- The nature of this role is highly externally focused, requiring frequent travel and meetings on and off campus during regular and non-traditional business hours, and is therefore expected to operate with high-levels of autonomy.
