A House United Information Sheet



In response to the devastating tornadoes that tore through Alabama April 27, Auburn University, the University of Alabama and Habitat for Humanity are moving the House United build project previously scheduled for Baldwin County to Tuscaloosa. Volunteers will work together on a building project that will aid in Tuscaloosa's tornado recovery efforts. Auburn will have two teams of volunteers working on the project during the week of July 18 through 22. One team will leave Auburn Monday, July 18, and return Wednesday evening. A second team will leave Auburn Wednesday morning and return Friday evening.

Trip Specifics

<u>Cost</u> - The cost for the trip is \$25. This will cover transportation, lodging, and some meals. All checks should be made payable to Auburn University. Volunteers who are providing their own transportation are not required to pay this fee. Participants should bring money for most meals. Because Habitat for Humanity is waiving their usual fees for this building project, all participants are encouraged to make a donation to the Tuscaloosa Habitat for Humanity Affiliate.

<u>Transportation</u> – Transportation will be provided for participants traveling with the teams leaving Auburn on Monday and Wednesday. Seating is limited. *Participants may elect to drive their own vehicles.*

Lodging - Participants will be lodged at Riverside West on the Campus of the University of Alabama. Beds and a linen packet will be provided, so you will not need to bring sheets or towels. You should bring a pillow and other basic toiletries.

<u>Work</u> - The project will involve manual labor outside, rain or shine. Be prepared to work hard and dress appropriately for hot weather.

<u>Due Date</u> – Please submit the application with payment by **July 8, 2011**. Participants will receive an agenda and additional information after the application deadline.
