Please be sure that all information requested on all forms is accurate.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

Selected exemplar proposals will articulate strategies that address disparities in knowledge; provide innovative methodologies, skill and program enhancing procedures; responsive to and inclusive of the interests of symposium attendees.

The numbers of concurrent session slots are limited. To accommodate as many exemplar proposals as possible, 15 minute symposia presentation slots are available.

Presenters (concurrent and poster sessions) will be notified of acceptance by March 23rd and must register for the symposium by March 30th.

Authors of manuscript submissions (including symposium presenters) will be notified of acceptance June 8th for proceedings publication.

Proposals will be selected by the OSS Program and Proceedings Publication Committee, at meetings convened by the Chair (Director of Faculty Engagement). A quorum will comprise 3-5 members present at the meeting. The OSS Program and Proceedings Publication committee will be composed of the AU administrators, faculty, and community representatives.
