

2025 Auburn University High School Symphonic Honor Band Festival

Parking Information and Logistics

Finding a parking place on the Auburn campus is difficult, even during a normal week. We enjoy having guests on campus, but parking is a challenge during special events such as the honor band. Though it is out of our control, we apologize for this inconvenience and hope that you will observe the following parking procedures.

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 27th - STUDENT DROP-OFF/ REGISTRATION

When you arrive at the Goodwin Music Building at 320 W. Samford Ave, you may drop off Honor Band Festival participants, along with their instruments, in front of the building on W. Samford Avenue. Please approach Goodwin on W Samford Ave from the east (College Street), so Goodwin will be on your right. There will be a line of cars, but you may pull into the loading zone and leave your student at the courtyard so they can go inside and check in.

If you prefer, you may park in visitor parking, and then walk your student to Goodwin. Students who are driving themselves should follow the parking procedures below.

Parking options for Thursday afternoon rehearsals:

Visitor Parking in Stadium Parking Deck

Continue west on W Samford past Goodwin, and turn right on Duncan Drive. You will see the parking deck straight ahead. It is highlighted in orange and marked as #125 on the attached map.

You may park on the 4th level of the Stadium Deck in the guest/visitor parking. These spaces are marked, and are along the wall facing the stadium side.

South Quad Parking Deck

If the stadium deck is full, you may park on the 3rd level and ramp going to the 4th level of the South Quad Parking Deck. This deck is at the corner of Duncan Drive and Lem Morrison Avenue (330 Lem Morrison Avenue), highlighted in orange on the map and marked as #130-131.

We recommend that you download the AU Parking app from the Apple Store or Google Play Store. Here is the web version:

The app will tell you if there are spots available in stadium deck (Listed as “Stadium Garage” on the app).

If you receive a ticket for parking in a staff or student spot without a permit, we cannot have it excused. If you park illegally, there is a possibility your car will be towed.

Thursday Evening

Following the Thursday evening rehearsal, you may pick up your students outside Goodwin Music Building in the same place they were dropped off for registration (320 W Samford Ave). There will be a long line of cars so please be patient.

If you prefer, you may park in any A, B, or C spot, including the lot at the corner of Duncan Drive and W Samford, and levels 2 and 3 of the stadium parking deck, and meet your student at Goodwin. Any spot marked A, B, or C is fine *after 5:30pm only*.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28th - REHEARSAL DROP-OFF AND PARKING

Goodwin Music Building

Students can be dropped off and picked up in front of Goodwin Music Building on W. Samford Avenue. Parent/chaperone attendance is not required at rehearsal. If you would like to attend rehearsal, follow the parking instructions from Thursday.

Students who drive should follow the parking instructions for Thursday.

Friday Evening Concert

The Gogue Performing Arts Center is located at 910 South College Street, approximately 1/2 mile from Goodwin Music Building. Please park in the large lot on the north side of Woodfield Drive, and refer to the enclosed map.

All concertgoers should park in the public parking lot north of Woodfield drive. Follow the signs for honor band participants and families. You will walk past the first set of front doors, and enter through the next set.

SATURDAY, MARCH 1st - Gogue Performing Arts Center - Final Performance

All performers will need to be dropped off at the **front entrance** of the GPAC at their assigned time, or they may park in the public parking lot on the north side of Woodfield drive.

Instrument cases must be left in cars Saturday morning. We do not have room for cases in the GPAC.

Our staff will be happy to answer any parking questions that you have during the honor band.
